NEEDS ASSESSMENT

Determining What Data to Pursue

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Watch the video individually or with a team. As you watch, consider how you currently determine what data to collect.

AFTER WATCHING THE VIDEO, DISCUSS AND ANSWER THESE QUESTIONS:

- How do you determine what the problem is? Where do you start? Is it a bottom-up or a top-down process?
- How do you know what data to collect? What drives the data you collect?

NOW, PUT WHAT YOU'VE LEARNED TO WORK:

- Discuss some problems with which you are currently grappling. Reach consensus about one problem to examine for this exercise. Write a short statement of the problem.
- Determine what data you will need to collect to be sure you have identified the correct problem. Specify how you will access the data, who will be responsible, and when your team will come back together to confirm that you have identified a worthy problem.
- Once you are sure you have identified the real problem, you are ready to think about Improvement Planning.
