# TEACHER QUALITY

## Bite-Sized Feedback

The purpose of this guide is to recognize that observation and feedback are crucial to the development of teachers when done frequently and collaboratively. While you watch, consider the effectiveness of current teacher observations/evaluations.

- Create a teaching curriculum for campus staff with input from administration and teachers.
- Determine a list of non-negotiable instructional strategies which should be used in all classrooms.
- Develop areas of focus with teachers individually to foster the process of practice and feedback that is based on dialogue and observation data.
- Offer feedback that is focused on one strategy at a time until mastery is observed.
- Include opportunities for peer collaboration and teacher reflection throughout the process.
